In the context of art, balance refers to the distribution of visual weight in a composition, ensuring that various elements come together in a way that feels stable and aesthetically pleasing.






PRINCIPLE OF HIERARCHY


Hierarchy serves as a guide.

This involves creating a focal point or center of attention within a composition. It's a technique used to guide the viewer's eye to the most critical or interesting part of a design.






PRINCIPLE OF RHYTHM

It plays a crucial role in creating visual interest, enhancing organization, and conveying a sense of harmony within a design.






PRINCIPLE OF SPACE






Movement directs the viewer's eyes.


VARIATION
